PROGRAMME SPECIFIC OUTCOME

The Department of Political Science is offering two programs- B.A. Honours and B.A. General in Political Science which covers a comprehensive set of courses ranging from the study of political theories, comparative politics, Indian politics, International Relations, Public Administration and Human Rights.

The expected learning outcomes of these programmes are as follows:

- 1) Through the comprehensive understanding of the subject both theoretical and practical aspects, students are expected to develop critical thinking and arguments.
- 2) Study of political systems around the world not only gives knowledge but also train students towards comparative approaches and methods.
- 3) Students develop an understanding of the international political system as it is and as it ought to be.

- 10) The study of politics helps in inculcating the values of tolerance, progressiveness and fraternity among the students. This contributes towards the making of a healthy and prosperous society.
