## **BRIEF HISTORY OF THE COLLEGE**

The establishment of MILLI AL-AMEEN COLLEGE by the MILLI EDUCATIONAL ORGANISATION (registered under the West Bengal Societies Registration Act -1961) fulfilled the long cherished desire of the Muslims of Kolkata to have a degree college for girls belonging to educationally backward sections of the society in general and Muslims in particulars. This is the first degree college in West Bengal to have been established by the Muslim Community since Independence. For the purpose of establishing the same the Organisation purchased a landed property of about 15 cottahs at 43, Hare Krishna Konar Road, Kolkata - 700 014 and got constructed a new four storeyed building thereon according to the plan sanctioned by the Calcutta Municipal Corporation, with donations, contributions and subscriptions collected over years from amongst the members and institutions of the Muslim Community. The foundation stone of the College building was laid on March 19, 1984, by the internationally reputed eminent Islamic scholar, Hazrat Maulana Syed Abul Hasan Ali Nadvi.

In the year 1992, in anticipation of getting affiliation from the University of Calcutta, the college was formally started with a batch of 40 female students and Classes for the B.A. (Pass) Two-year Degree Course were duly commenced under qualified lady teachers. Three batches of students, appeared successfully in the Calcutta University Examinations as external candidates. However, certain technical difficulties that arose due to non-affiliation of the college led to its closure in 1996. Meanwhile, vigorous efforts for early affiliation to the Calcutta University continued and eventually after much persuasion the College received a formal letter of approval from the Govt, of West Bengal (vide G.O. No. 572 - Edn (CS)/4C-3/98 dated 24.04.2000) followed by the grant of affiliation from the University of Calcutta (vide Memo No. C/590/298Affl. dated 02.06.2000). Consequently the college began functioning as an institution of higher education affiliated to the Calcutta University with effect from the academic session 2000-01 The National Commission For Minority Educational Institutions granted minority status to this college under Article 30 of the constitution of India vide their order-FNO. 775 of 8th October, 2008. Issued on 13th October, 2008. The Minority Affairs and Madarsah Education Department of the Govt, of West Bengal vide their letter no. 18-MDW/2009 dated 12.01.2009 have also informed that the above certificate will hold good for the purpose of recognition of this educational Institution as minority educational institution. At present the Milli Educational Organisation, with the active support of its donors, members, subscribers and philanthropic members of the Muslim Community at large meets a part of the recurring expenses such as payment of salaries to part-time teaching and non-teaching staff and intends to do so till the college achieves self-sufficiency and generates its own resources.

## **AIMS AND OBJECTIVES**

Milli Al-Ameen College (for Girls) now stands as a recognized minority educational institution. The College aims at imparting general education, disseminating knowledge, inculcating human values and discipline and developing the total personality with all round physical and intellectual growth of the students to make them enlightened citizens of India. It endeavors to create an atmosphere adapted to the requirements of female students and congenial to their academic pursuits; to enable them to develop their talents thereby asserting their position in the society. The College also believes in propagating secular values that enable the students to adjust harmoniously in a pluralistic society. The College provides education in the following subjects, viz. English, Urdu, Bengali, Geography, History, Islamic History and culture, Education and Political Science at the B.A. Level. Honours courses are available in English, Urdu, Education, History and Political Science. The B. Com (General Three - Year) Degree Course has been introduced from the academic session 2003-04 The B.Sc. General 3 Year Degree Course In Bio-Science (Botany, Chemistry and Zoology) commenced from the academic session 2010-2011, and the Pure Science Course (Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics) to Commence soon. The medium of instruction is English.



## **ACADEMIC SESSION**

The academic session commences from the month of July every year and ends on the 30th of June in the next year and consists of two Semesters.

### **MEDIUM OF INSTRUCTION**

The medium of instruction is English. However students are permitted to write their examinations in Bengali in all subjects except English and Urdu.

**NOTE :** Any student opting for GEOGRAPHY as an elective subject must go for a COMPULSORY two / three day educational excursion out of the city. This excursion is compulsory for the B.A. General Examination of Calcutta University.

**ADMISSION PROCEDURE**

Admission Form and Prospectus priced at Rs. 100.00 only are available after the publication of the results of the West Bengal Higher Secondary Examinations on furnishing the Original Class XII marksheet. B/A.

For SC/ST candidates 40% in the subject and 40% in the aggregate are required for Honours.

**DISCIPLINARY MATTERS**

1. In case of continuous absence from college for three consecutive days students must submit a letter signed by the guardian stating clearly the reason for absence.
2. Students must bring their Identity Cards daily and especially at the time of the College Examinations.
3. Loss of Identity Card should be immediately reported in writing to the Principal so that a duplicate one may be issued.
4. Change of address should be immediately notified in writing to the office.
5. In order to avail of the Games in the Common Room, Student must deposit their Identity Cards with the office clerk.
6. Students should not loiter in the corridors, passages or sit back in the Common Room during class or leave the classes without taking permission from the teacher.
7. Students are not allowed to stand on the terrace or roof ramparts of the College. While visiting the library, all bags must be kept outside. Only Money bags, note books and cell phones (Switched Off) will be allowed inside the library. No printed matter can be carried into the library.
8. Violations of any of the rules and regulations of the College will be severely dealt with by imposition of fines, suspension from class or even expulsion from the College.
9. Students must not use any unfair means in any examination or Class Tests.
10. Students must not call vendors of any goods into the College premises.
11. No business or financial transaction among students should be made without prior permission from the Principal.
12. Guardians should not enter the class rooms or the common room of the College without prior permission.
13. Students are forbidden from using cell phones during college hours. Camera Phones are not allowed inside the college premises. Failure to abide by this rule will entail a fine of Rs. 200.00 along with confiscation of phone.
14. Students must come decently dressed to the College.
15. Students must maintain the decorum of the College.
16. Students must not disfigure the walls or furniture or misuse any property of the college



- or invite outsiders into the common room or classrooms of the College.
17. Picnics and Excursions arranged by the College will be notified to the guardians and their written permission will be required before the student is allowed to go on such a trip.
  18. Students must attend Flag Hoisting Functions on Independence Day and Republic Day and on other occasions such as College Foundation Day otherwise they will be penalized.
  19. Students must read the Notice Board regularly and follow their daily academic timetable carefully.
  20. Students must take care of their personal belongings. The college is not responsible for any loss or theft.
  21. Guardians can meet the Teacher-in-Charge with prior permission and / or appointment.

### **LIBRARY RULES & REGULATIONS**

The College has a well-equipped Library-cum-Reading room for the students of this College to study or do reference work. Besides the Reference Section, there is the general Borrowing Section in which students are allowed to borrow two or three books at a time according to their library cards. The following rules apply in the library.

- (i) Students must maintain order, discipline and complete silence in the Library and Reading Room.
- (ii) Cell phones must be switched off.
- (iii) Each student will be issued Borrowing Cards - two for the General Course students and three for the Honours Course students. Fresh Library cards will be issued at the beginning of every new Academic Session. Each student will also be issued one Reference Card which will remain valid throughout their three-year course of study in this college. Library Cards must be obtained within one month of the commencement of the Academic Session.
- (iv) In order to avail of Library Cards, Honours students must submit 4 stamp-size photographs and General Students 3 stamp-size photographs to the Library Clerk within a week of the commencement of classes.
- (v) Books may be borrowed for a period of five consecutive days (excluding Sundays and other Public Holidays) after which a fine of Rs.10.00/- per book per day will be levied. Books may be reissued on their return for another period of three days if they have not already been requisitioned by others. Books returned late after vacations or extended holidays will be levied a late fine of Rs 20/- per book per day. All Fines must be paid by the students through their respective Fees Book after obtaining Late Fine / Penalty Slip from the Library Clerk.
- (vi) Books must be handled with care and the borrower must check the condition of the book at the time of borrowing. Any damage or defacement must be brought to the notice of the Lib. Clerk immediately and before taking the book out of the library. In case of damage found in the book and shown at the time of borrowing the last borrower will be held responsible.
- (vii) Any book lost, damaged or defaced must be replaced by the borrower. If such a book is one of a series and cannot be replaced singly, then the entire series must be replaced.
- (viii) Should the book lost, damaged or defaced be rare or out of print, the borrower must pay a fine in addition to the published price. Till the damage is compensated, the student's library card will be confiscated and she will be debarred from using the library.
- (ix) The College Library will remain open during Summer Recess.
- (x) Theft of books from the Library will be severely punished.

### **FACILITIES FOR STUDENTS**

The College has a spacious Common Room for the students. This is equipped with various indoor games. Facilities for the games may be used by the students if they deposit their Identity Card with the Office Clerk. The Common Room must not be used to avoid classes or to entertain personal visitors of the students. Students must keep the Common Room clean and free of litter. Any damage done to the indoor games will have to be compensated by the students responsible for the damage.


## تعارف

ملی ایجوکیشنل آرگنائزیشن کے ماتحت ملی الامین کالج (برائے خواتین) کا قیام مغربی بنگال وکولکاتا کے مسلمانوں کی ڈگری کالج کے دیرینہ خواہوں کی تعبیر ہے۔ بالخصوص سماج کے تعلیمی طور پر پسماندہ مسلم طبقہ کے لئے اس کا قیام عمل میں آیا۔ آزادی کے بعد مغربی بنگال میں مسلمانوں کی کوششوں سے قائم ہونے والا یہ پہلا اور واحد اقلیتی تعلیمی ادارہ ہے۔ اس کالج کی تعمیر کے لئے ملی ایجوکیشنل آرگنائزیشن نے ۱۵ اکرٹھاراضی پر مشتمل زمین ۴۳، ہرے کرشن کوناروڈ، کولکاتا-۱۴ میں خریدی اور کولکاتا میونسپل کارپوریشن کے ذریعہ منظور شدہ پلان کے تحت چار منزلہ عمارت تعمیر کروائی۔ یہ کالج سماج کے اہل خیر و دیگر باذوق حضرات کے چندہ و تعاون کا ہی نتیجہ ہے کہ ایک خوبصورت عمارت کی بنیاد ۱۹ مارچ ۱۹۸۴ء میں بین الاقوامی شہرت یافتہ شخصیت اور اسلامی اسکالر حضرت مولانا سید ابوالحسن علی ندوی کے دست مبارک سے پڑی۔

۱۹۹۲ء میں کولکاتا یونیورسٹی سے الحاق سے قبل ۴۰ طالبات پر مشتمل B.A(Pass) کا دو سالہ ڈگری کورس کلاس شروع کیا گیا جس کے لئے کچھ تجربہ کار و ماہر استانیوں کی مدد لی گئی۔ تین متواتر batch کی کامیابی کے بعد کچھ ناگزیر تکنیکی دشواریوں کے سبب ۱۹۹۶ء میں اس سلسلے کو بند کر دینا پڑا۔ بڑی کوششوں کے بعد بالآخر ۲۰۰۰ء میں اس کا الحاق کلکتہ یونیورسٹی سے ہو گیا۔ اور تب سے یہ گرس کالج متواتر ایک اعلیٰ تعلیمی ادارے کے طور پر کام کر رہا ہے ۲۰۰۸ء سے یہ ادارہ قومی کمیشن برائے اقلیتی تعلیمی ادارہ جات کے تحت اقلیتی حیثیت حاصل کر چکا ہے ساتھ ہی حکومت مغربی بنگال کے اقلیتی امور و مدرسہ تعلیم نے بھی ۲۰۰۹ء میں اس ادارے کی اقلیتی حیثیت کو تسلیم کیا ہے۔ فی الحال ملی ایجوکیشنل آرگنائزیشن ملت کے مختلف شعبہ حیات سے تعلق رکھنے والے باذوق و غیر حضرات کے تعاون سے اسکے دیگر جزوقتی تدریسی و غیر تدریسی اسٹاف کا خرچ چلا رہا ہے۔ مگر اسے خود مختار و خود کفیل بنانے کی کوشش بھی جاری ہے۔
