

International Mother Language Day

The Departments of Urdu and Bengali, Milli Al-Ameen College (For Girls) observed International Mother Language Day on 21st February 2025.

International Mother Language Day is a worldwide annual observance held on 21st February to promote awareness of linguistic and cultural diversity and to promote multilingualism and to preserve mother tongues. The day was initiated by Bangladesh and has been celebrated since 2000. The program gave students a golden opportunity to understand the history of this particular day and to promote and preserve their own language.

The program started with an introduction by Dr. Naghma Nigar (Assistant Professor and HoD of Urdu) and Pavel Sultana (Guest faculty in dept. of Bengali).
