4. Necessary skill sets to groom for the future

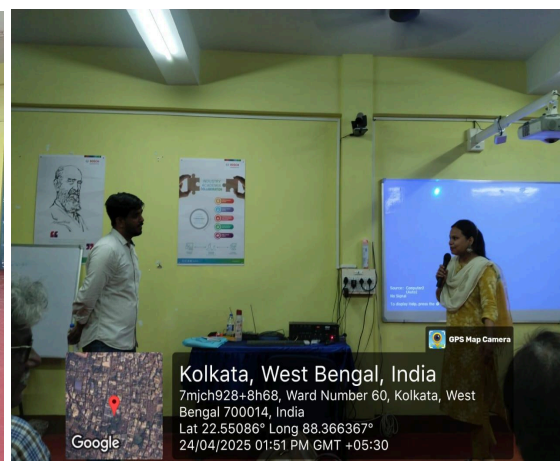
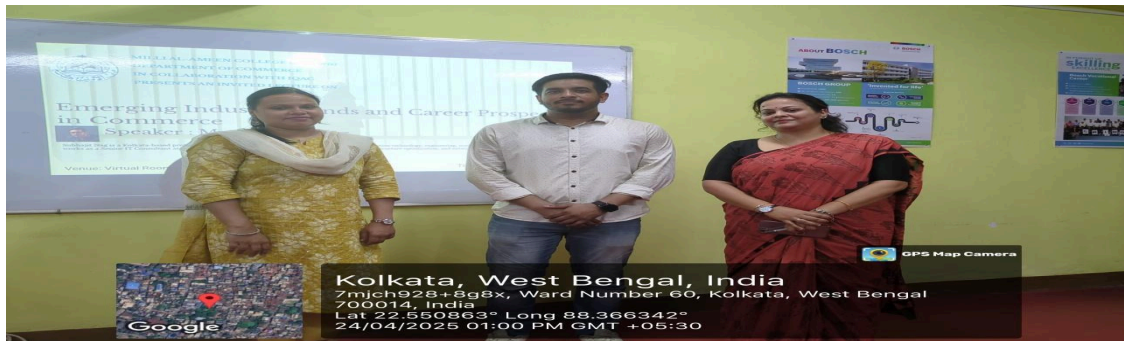
