Report on Awareness programme entitled “Go Green: Say no to plastics”

The Indian government has taken several steps to address plastic waste in accordance to the ethos of the “Swatchh Bharat Abhiyan”. This includes bans on certain types of plastic and initiatives promoting recycling. However, there are challenges in enforcing these policies effectively. One of the most significant steps taken by the government is the implementation of the Plastic Waste Management Rules, which aim to reduce the use of single-use plastic and promote the use of alternative materials. The rules require manufacturers to take responsibility for the collection and disposal of plastic waste and encourage the use of eco-friendly packaging materials. Another measure taken by the government is the Swachh Bharat Abhiyan, a nationwide campaign launched in 2014 to improve cleanliness and sanitation in India. As part of this campaign, the government has set up various initiatives to increase the collection and segregation of plastic waste, such as door-to-door collection, community bins, and plastic waste collection centres.

On 19.04.2022, students of Science Department presented posters in an awareness programme organised by the Departments of Science and Department of Political Science in collaboration with IQAC and Green Club. The title of the awareness programme was “Go Green- Say No to Plastics”.

The students presented posters and also interacted with local people to create awareness. The local people were shown different types of plastic samples and explained the effects they have on environment. Antalina Kar, Head of the department, Botany also enlightened the local people about the raising issues. Our respected principal Dr. Sunanda Haldar and members of Governing Body graced the event.
