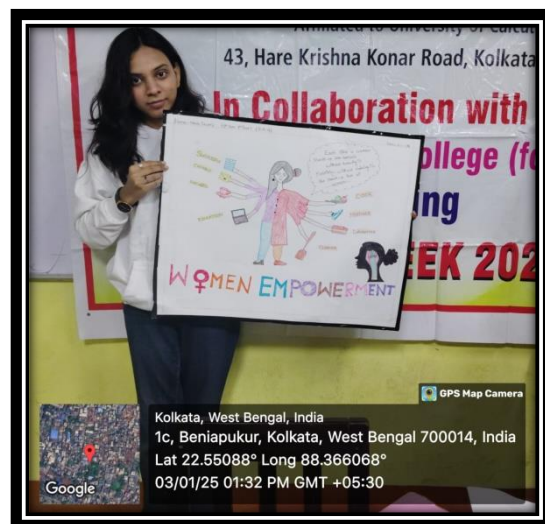

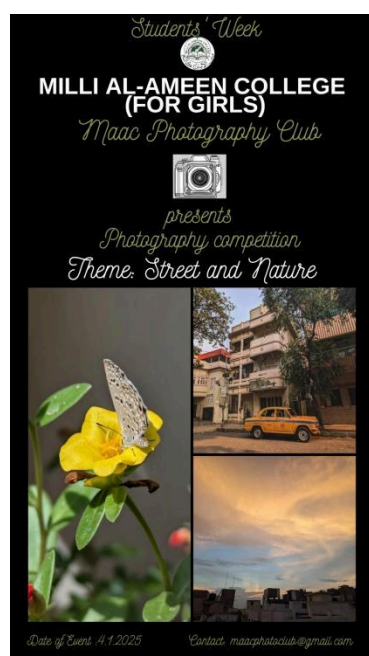

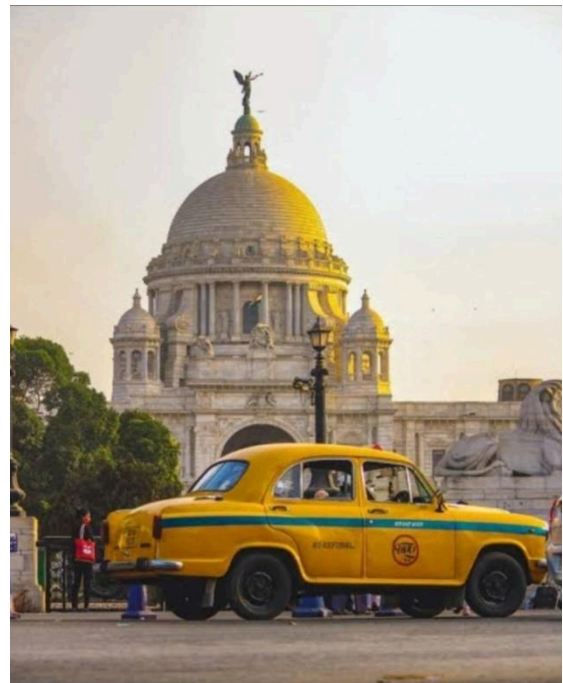

Further, students registered themselves for the psychometric test and got their career counseling done. They were further provided with the final report of the aforesaid test.

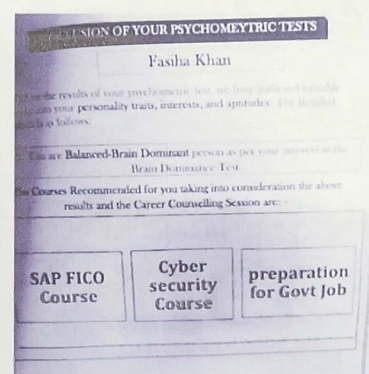
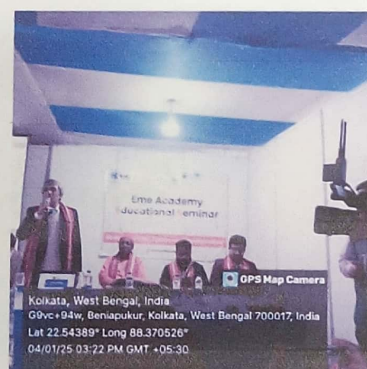
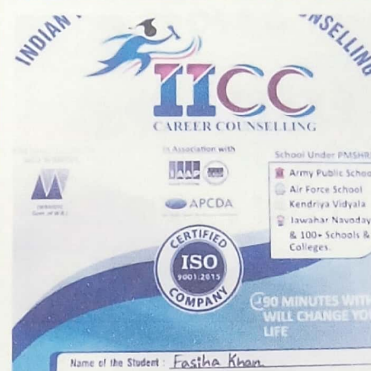
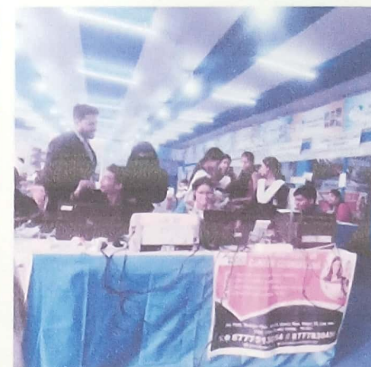
